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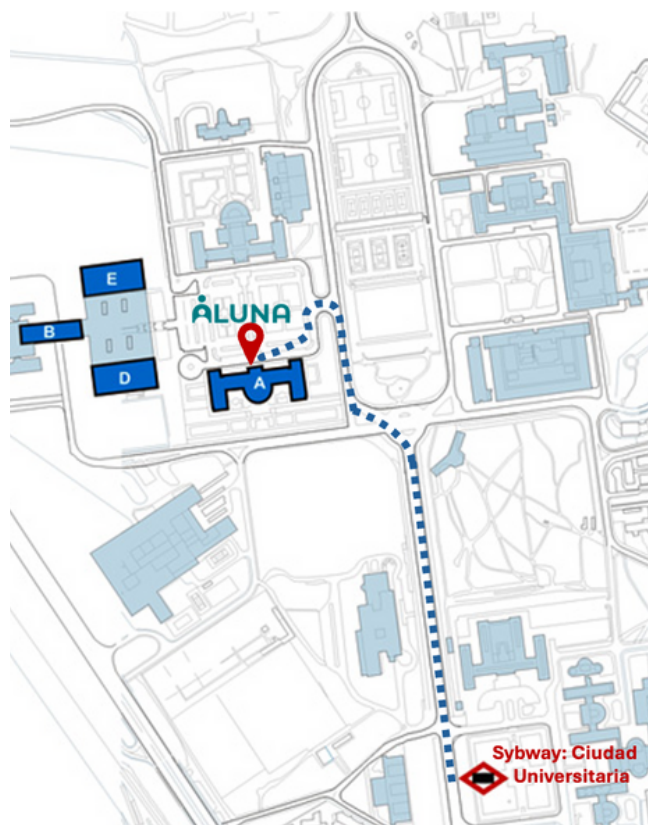
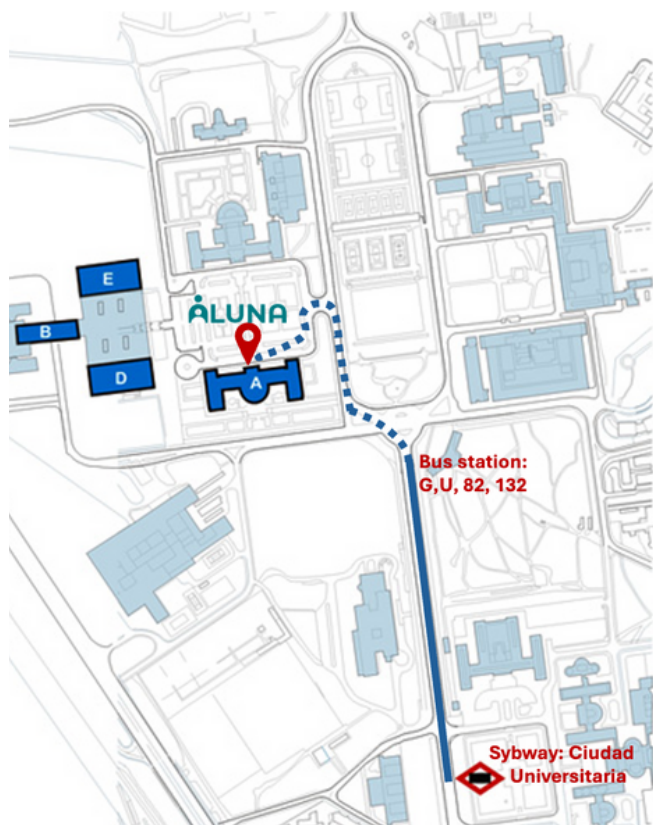
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U: University Bus since Subway station “Ciudad Universitaria”
